Street Name Change?

A key Community Board 10 committee will hold a meeting on May 13 to discuss a proposal by local resident Christian Zaino to rename a Dyker Heights street corner after a historical figure.

Zaino, historian of the Dyker Heights Civic Association, is pushing for the city to name the corner of 11th Avenue and 82nd Street "Walter L. Johnson Corner," in honor of the developer who founded the Dyker Heights community.

The committee meeting will take place at 7 p.m. on May 13 at Board

10's office, 8119 Fifth Ave.

The committee will vote on the recommendation and will present its position to the full board at a meeting on May 18.

At the May 13 meeting, the committee will discuss other issues, including the ongoing problem of drivers who park their cars on sidewalks and a request for parking meters to be installed in front of 810 66th St. and 6820 Eighth Ave.
